



Admission Process:

Eligibility for MBA Admission

MBA: Through Common Entrance Test (MHCET/CMAT/MAT/CAT/XAT/ATMA) Administered by DTE.

Minimum bachelor's degree or appeared for final year examination of a bachelor's degree & must pass the examination with requisite % marks on or before the date as published by DTE in any discipline of three years duration with minimum 50 % or more marks for general category students.

Students belonging to SC/ST/VJ DT NT(A)/NT(B)/NT(C)/NT(D)/SBC/OBC/SEBC/EWS" from Maharashtra State requisite 45% or more marks in bachelor degree with Caste Certificate, Caste Validity, Non-Creamy Layer from any statutory University approved by the appropriate Government authority & recognized by Association of Indian Universities. The percentage of marks shall be calculated by rounding off to nearest integer. i.e. if the percentage of marks comes out to be 49.50° â to 49.99° â and 44.50% to 44.99 % then it shall be rounded to 50° â and 45% respectively and if the percentage of marks comes out to be 49.01 % to 49.49% and 44.01% to 44.49%, shall be rounded to 49% and 44% respectively for deciding the eligibility.

Must have completed the document verification as well as the selection procedure as prescribed by the competent authority from time to time (DTE).
