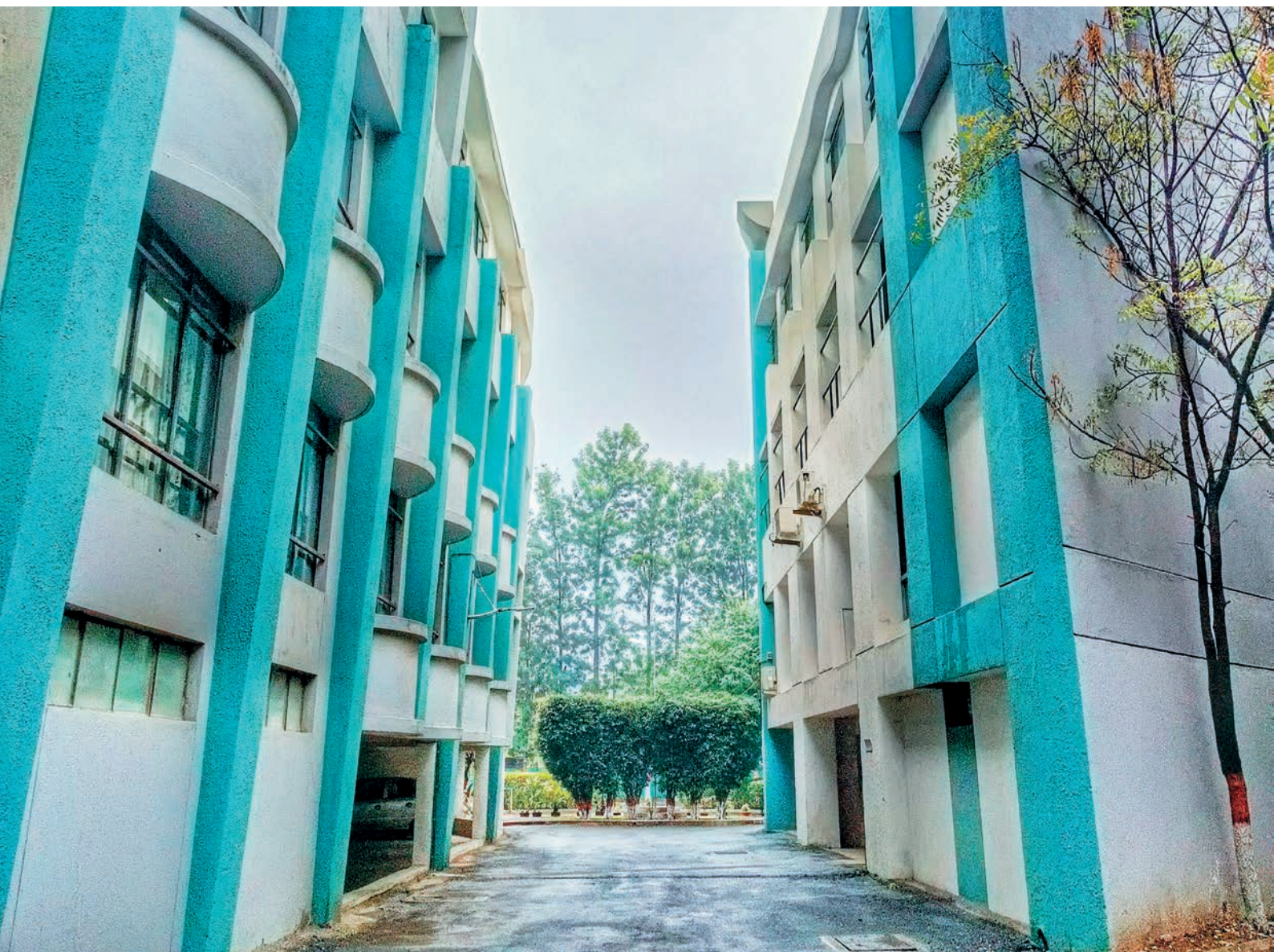

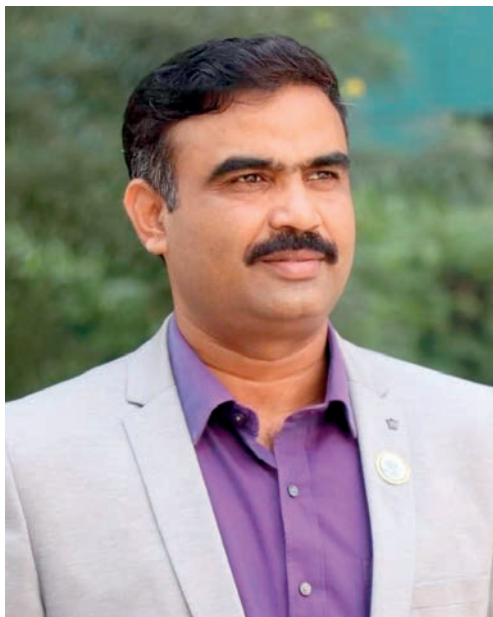

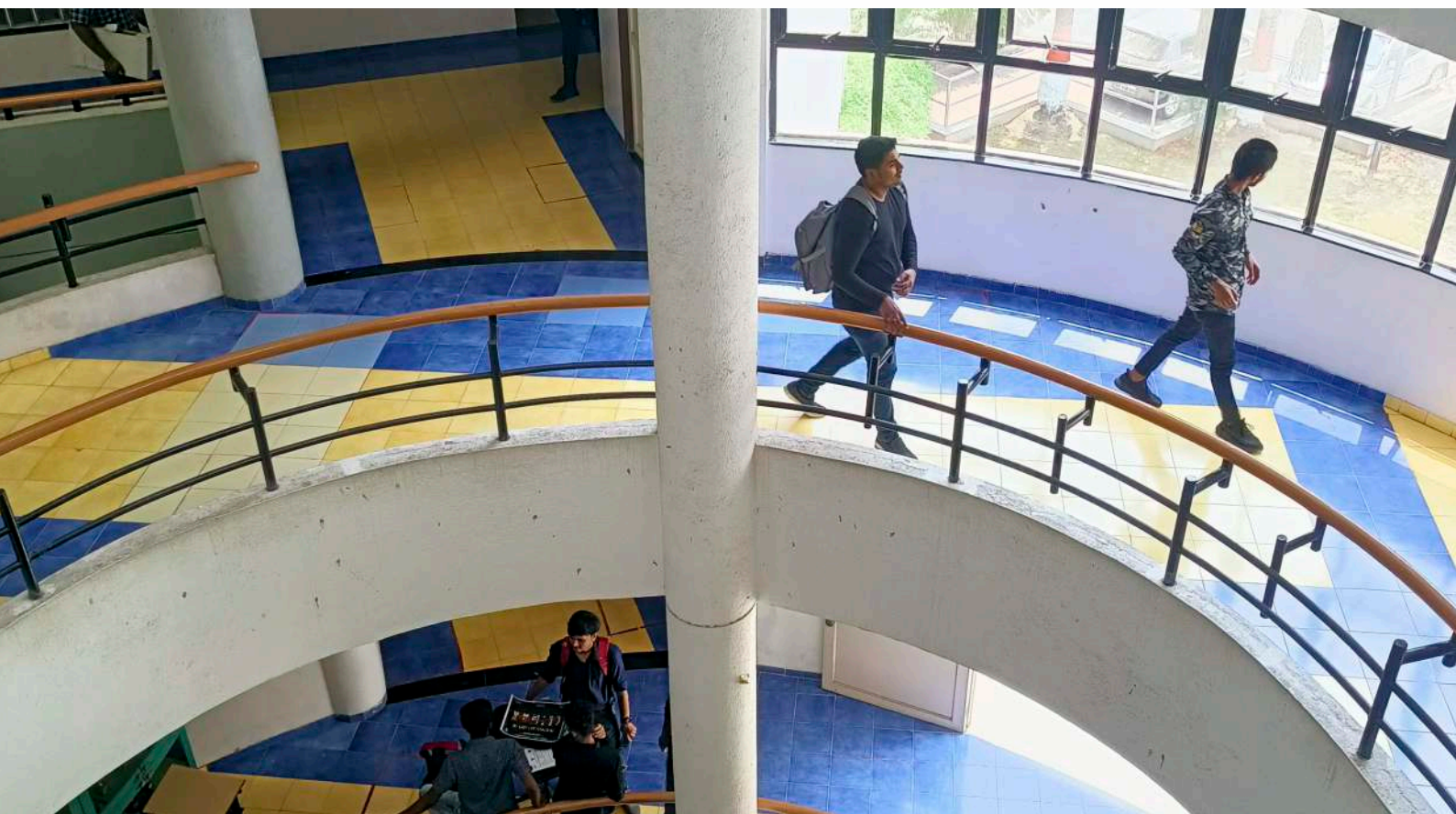

### Location

Indira college of Commerce & Science is situated at Tathawade besides the New Mumbai - Pune Highway with its sprawling and pristine campus providing environment conducive to learning and all rounded development of students. ### Library
